An unforgettable journey through ancient rainforest

Experience one of Australia's most spectacular rail journeys aboard Kuranda Scenic Railway. Travel through the heart of Din Din (Barron Gorge) National Park as you discover the wonders of ancient World Heritage-listed Wet Tropics Rainforest.

Immerse yourself in the journey where breathtaking scenery, towering waterfalls and deep ravines unfold. Rising from sea level to 327 metres, the train winds its way through 15 hand-made tunnels and over 55 bridges to the mountain village of Ngunbay (Kuranda), meaning 'place of the platypus'.

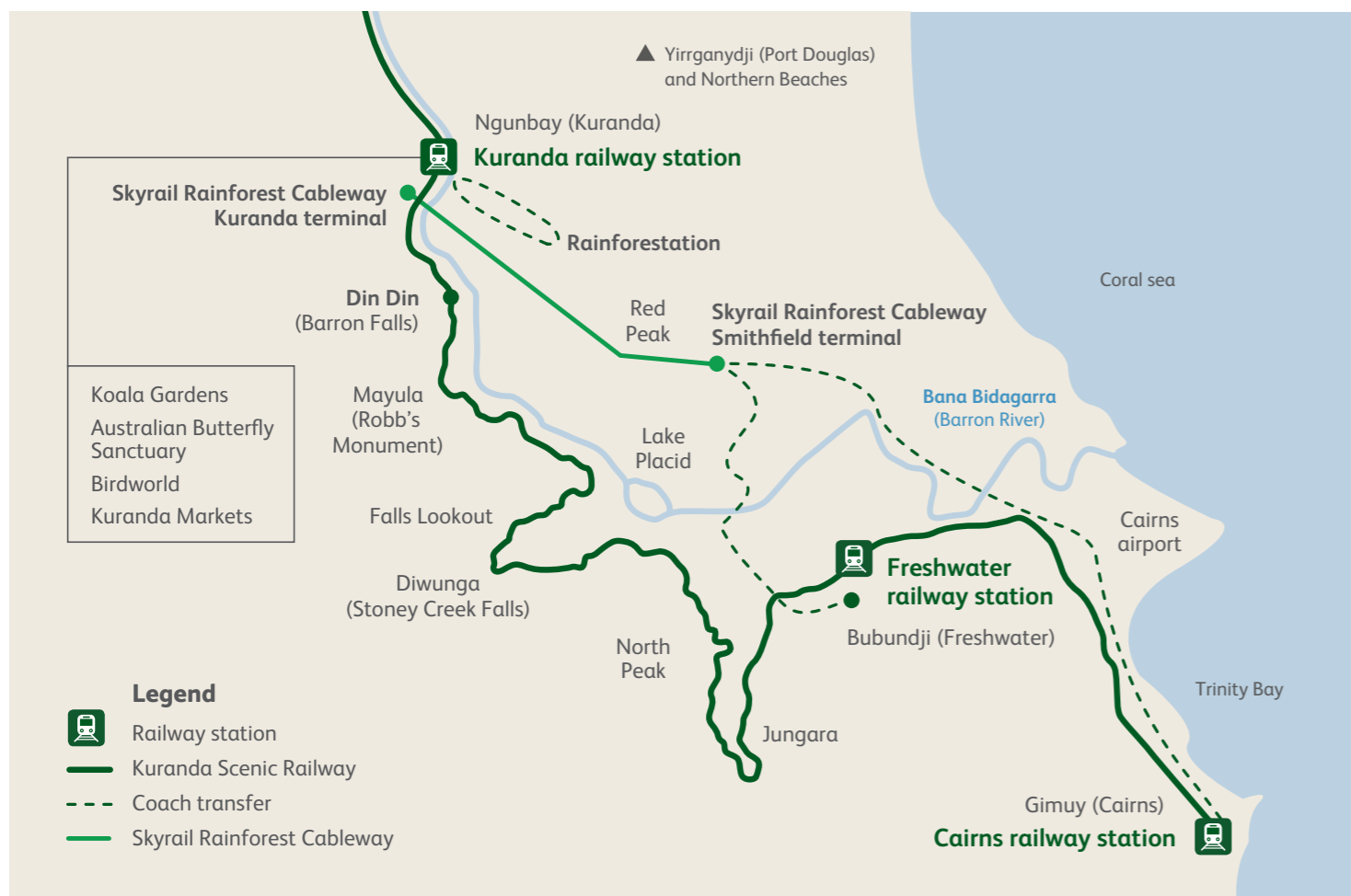
Step back in time as you travel in heritage carriages, some of which are more than 100 years old.

Hauled by 1720 class locomotives, they are adorned in the vibrant colours of the Buda-dji story from the Traditional Owners of the Country we travel through.

This heritage-listed railway line opened in 1891, is an engineering feat which has stood the test of time. Learn more about the cultural significance, history and points of interest with audio commentary along the way.

This immersive journey takes approximately two hours each way. You can join the train journey from either Gimuy (Cairns), Bubundji (Freshwater) or Ngunbay (Kuranda) railway stations. To enhance your Kuranda experience, complement your railway adventure with one of our day tour packages.

Kuranda Scenic Railway offers two timeless travel options. Choose from either Heritage or Gold Class. We have a dedicated accessible carriage on every service with boarding available at all stations, except Din Din (Barron Falls) station, where access is by steps only.

Water coolers and toilets are located in every carriage. Being a heritage railway, the carriages are not air-conditioned. The train has large, open-air windows, bringing you closer to the scents of the rainforest and mist of the waterfalls you pass by, all part of the charm of this railway experience.

Hop aboard and enjoy the scenery and numerous photographic opportunities as you wind through World Heritage-listed rainforest.

Experience Kuranda Scenic Railway from Cairns or Freshwater railway station to Kuranda and visit the Australian Butterfly Sanctuary, Birdworld and Kuranda Koala Gardens. In the afternoon return on Skyrail Rainforest Cableway. Depart from Kuranda at 1.30pm or 3.30pm to Freshwater and 2.30pm or 3.30pm to Cairns, with a transfer from Skyrail Smithfield terminal to your railway station.

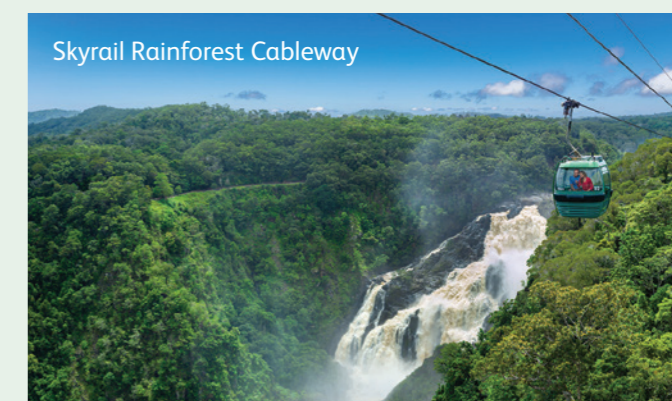

Car parking

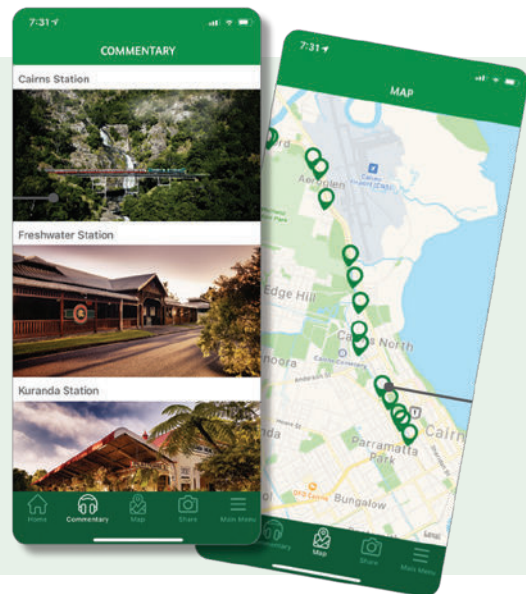
Free car parking is available at all railway stations. At Cairns railway station, please provide your vehicle registration number when collecting your rail ticket to validate your car parking ticket.
